

Rent-A-Cabins at Eldon Hazlet State Park

The primitive, two-room cabins are equipped with only the bare essentials: one full-sized bed with foam mattress, two sets of bunk beds with foam mattresses, an electric heater, a drop-leaf table with chairs, and ceiling fans. Many cabins are handicapped accessible and can be approached via vehicle. Showers, electricity, charcoal grills and picnic tables are available at the campgrounds; however, campers must bring their own bed linens and personal items. Dogs and other pets are not permitted.

Rent-a-Cabin Rules

- No pets are allowed inside or outside the cabin.
- No smoking in units.
- No tents or additional camping units permitted on cabin sites.
- You must be 18 years of age or older to rent the cabins
- Vehicles must use parking lot (no driving on the grass)
- No cooking/grilling inside the cabin or on porch deck
- Fires are restricted to fire rings ONLY
- Check-in time is 3:00pm and check-out time is 1:00pm
- Upon departure, the cabin rental check-out list must be turned into the Campground Host
- Park management reserves the right to remove any person(s) for violation of any state park rules, regulations or posted notices.
