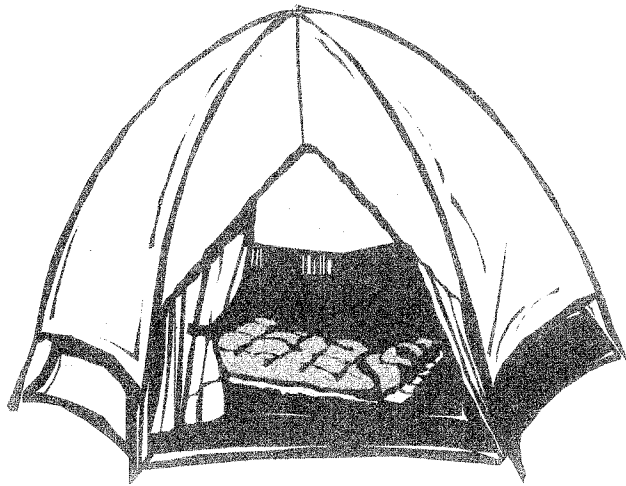

## Campground Facts

**Number of Sites: 61**

- \* Class A: 34 (Vehicle Access with Electric)
  - Fox Squirrel -and- Gray Squirrel
- \* Class B: 6 (Vehicle Access / No Electric)
  - Gray Squirrel
- \* Class C: 20 (Walk-In Tent / No Electric)
  - Fox Tent -and- Gray Tent
- \* Group: 1 (Tents Only / No Electric)
  - Whippoorwill Group Camp

### **Amenities:**

- \* Picnic Table and Grill at Each Site
  - Firewood available at Concession
- \* Shower Building with Flush Toilets
- \* Sanitary Dump Station
- \* Water Hydrants - Various Locations
- \* Restrooms and Visitor Parking
- \* Playground Equipment
- \* Basketball Goal - 1/2 Court
- \* Fishing Piers and Floating Docks
- \* Horseshoe Pit - Fox Squirrel
- \* Handicap Accessible Facilities
  - At various locations, including the shower building and 4 campsites

### **Pets are Welcome, but Please:**

- \* Keep your pets on a leash at all times
- \* Do not chain or tie your pet to trees
- \* Do not leave your pets unattended.
- \* Properly dispose of your animal's waste.
- \* Keep your pet quiet

### **Rates:**

- \* Class A: \$ 20.00 per Night
- \* Class A: Summer Holiday(s) Rate
  - \$ 30.00 per Night
- \* Class B: \$ 10.00 per Night
- \* Class C: \$ 8.00 per night
- \* Group: Type - per night
  - Youth: \$2 per Person / \$20 Minimum
  - Adult: \$4 per Person / \$40 Minimum
- \* Credit Cards Accepted: Yes (MC & Visa)

\*\*\* Special camping rate reductions apply to Illinois residents only

### **Reservation Information:**

- \* On-Line reservations must be made at least 5 days in advance
- \* Also, there is a 6 month booking window for on-line reservations
- \* Full payment is required at booking
- \* Reservations are recommended for stays that include weekend days
- \* If not reserved, campsites can be occupied on a first come / first serve basis... Please check reservation status before occupying a campsite

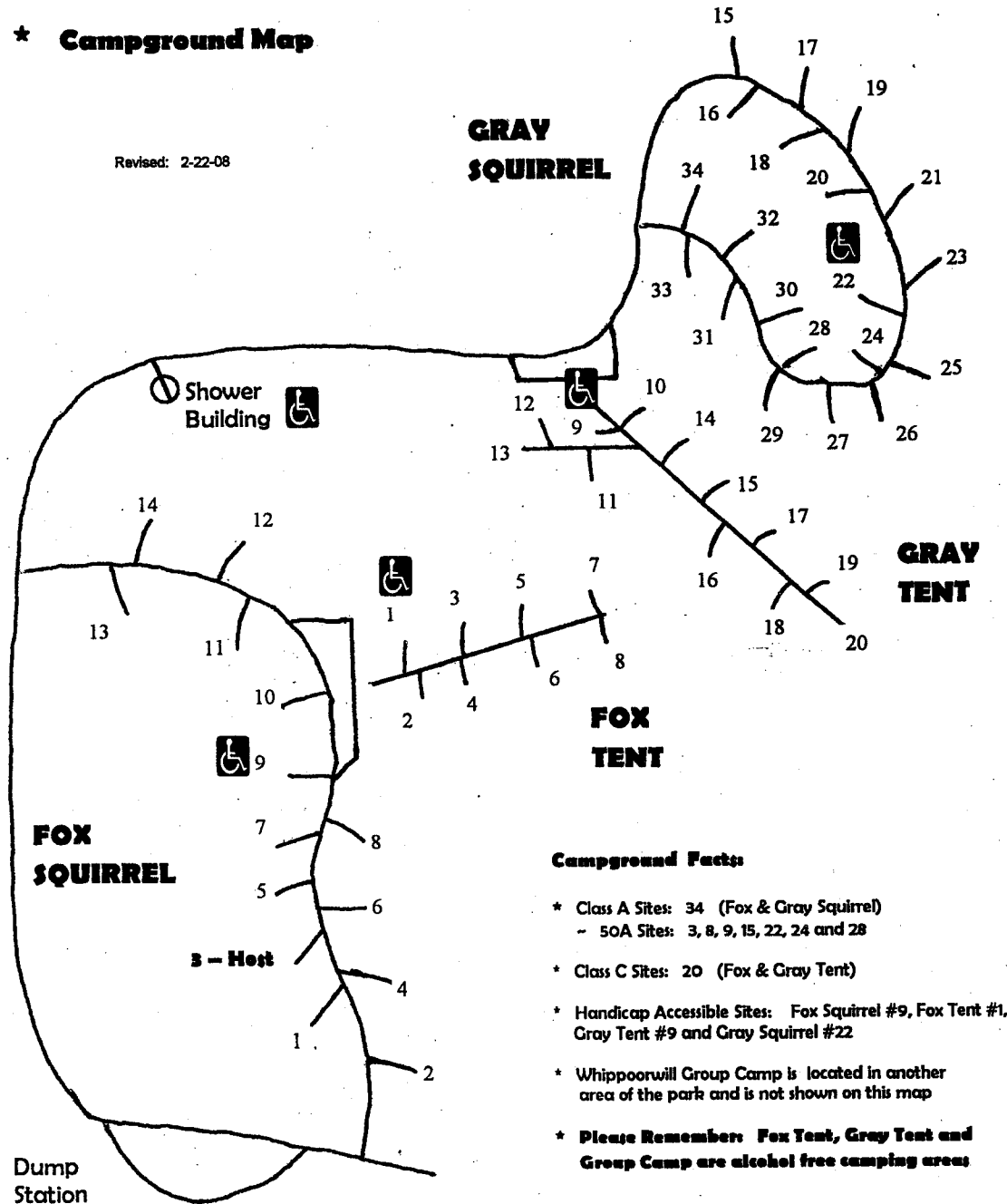
## Additional Facts

- \* **Park Hours: 7AM - 10PM**
- \* **Quiet Hours: 10 PM - 7AM**
  - All visitors are required to leave the park at or before 10 PM
- \* **Check – Out Time: 3 PM**
- \* No one under 18 years of age may register for a campsite or book a reservation
- \* **Maximum Length of Stay: 5/1 - 9/30**
  - 14 nights in any 30 day period
- \* Fox Tent, Gray Tent and the Whippoorwill Group Camp are **"Alcohol Free"** areas
- \* **Occupancy:**
  - **Class A, B & C:** Group size(s) cannot exceed the established maximum occupancy number as defined below:
    - ^ A "Single Family" campsite can have no more than 4 adults and all adults must occupy the same camping unit (FYI: An adult is defined as a person 18 years of age or older)
    - ^ A "Single Group" campsite can have a maximum of 4 occupants (FYI: Children, regardless of age, are included in the occupancy headcount)
  - **Group Camp:** Maximum of 40 People
- \* Normally, only 1 camping unit is allowed per site
- \* No more than 2 vehicles are allowed per site
  - All other vehicles must be parked in parking lots

- \* Class A Sites: 34 (Fox & Gray Squirrel)
  - 50A Sites: 3, 8, 9, 15, 22, 24 and 28
- \* Class C Sites: 20 (Fox & Gray Tent)
- \* Handicap Accessible Sites: Fox Squirrel #9, Fox Tent #1, Gray Tent #9 and Gray Squirrel #22
- \* Whippoorwill Group Camp is located in another area of the park and is not shown on this map
- \* **Please Remember: Fox Tent, Gray Tent and Group Camp are alcohol free camping areas**
